NOTE TO SCORE KEEPERS

The Board Member on Duty will bring the tablet out to the score booth before the game. They will have already logged in and gotten the game ready to go. The rosters are already uploaded into the teams. When the manager gives you the lineup, you just have to click on the order to set it. I will get the managers to also put starting positions on the lineup card to make it easier on you. The home team will be in charge of the tablet and the away team will be in charge of the score board. But we need both sides to work together on the tablet so nothing is missed. There will be a pad of paper and pencils by your side in case you need to write anything down to catch up later. There will also be old score books and pitch count sheets in there in case of any technical difficulties as a backup. Then later I can input it all in the app. When you are done, save and finalize the game. At that time the Board Member on Duty should be there to pick up the tablet and take it off your hands. REMEMBER: When you are in the score booth you are not allowed to cheer or coach. You are not allowed to call your manager over. You ARE allowed to talk to the umpire. If the manager comes up to you to ask a question, you can answer. If a pitcher goes over their pitch count, you are not allowed to tell your manager. But you do need to notify the umpire. Stats WILL NOT be available to the public. Since not all of you are professional score keepers, the numbers may not be accurate. Do your best when scoring, but don't stress out deciding if that was a hit or an error. Lower divisions, do your best replacing the fielders when they come in and out of the game. Upper divisions NEED to. The bottom line is the score needs to be correct and the pitch count needs to be accurate. Do your best and have fun with this. It is less stressful than the regular scorebook. Work together. I will be hanging out all day Opening Day to make sure the games run smoothly through the app.

Majors/Intermediate

Very important to put the substitutions in. Even if the 1st substitution is in the field before they come up to hit, they need to be recorded. I will make sure the managers are letting you know when this happens. The app keeps track of playing time and it is a way we can use to make sure everyone is at least getting the minimum playing time.

Minor B

Since there are no walks in Minor B, DO NOT press pitch on the last ball that would give the batter a walk. Wait to click on pitch until the last pitch of the player's at bat against the coach's pitch.
